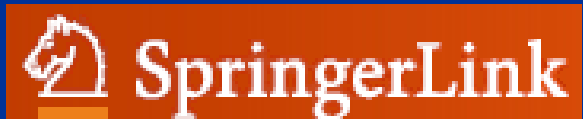

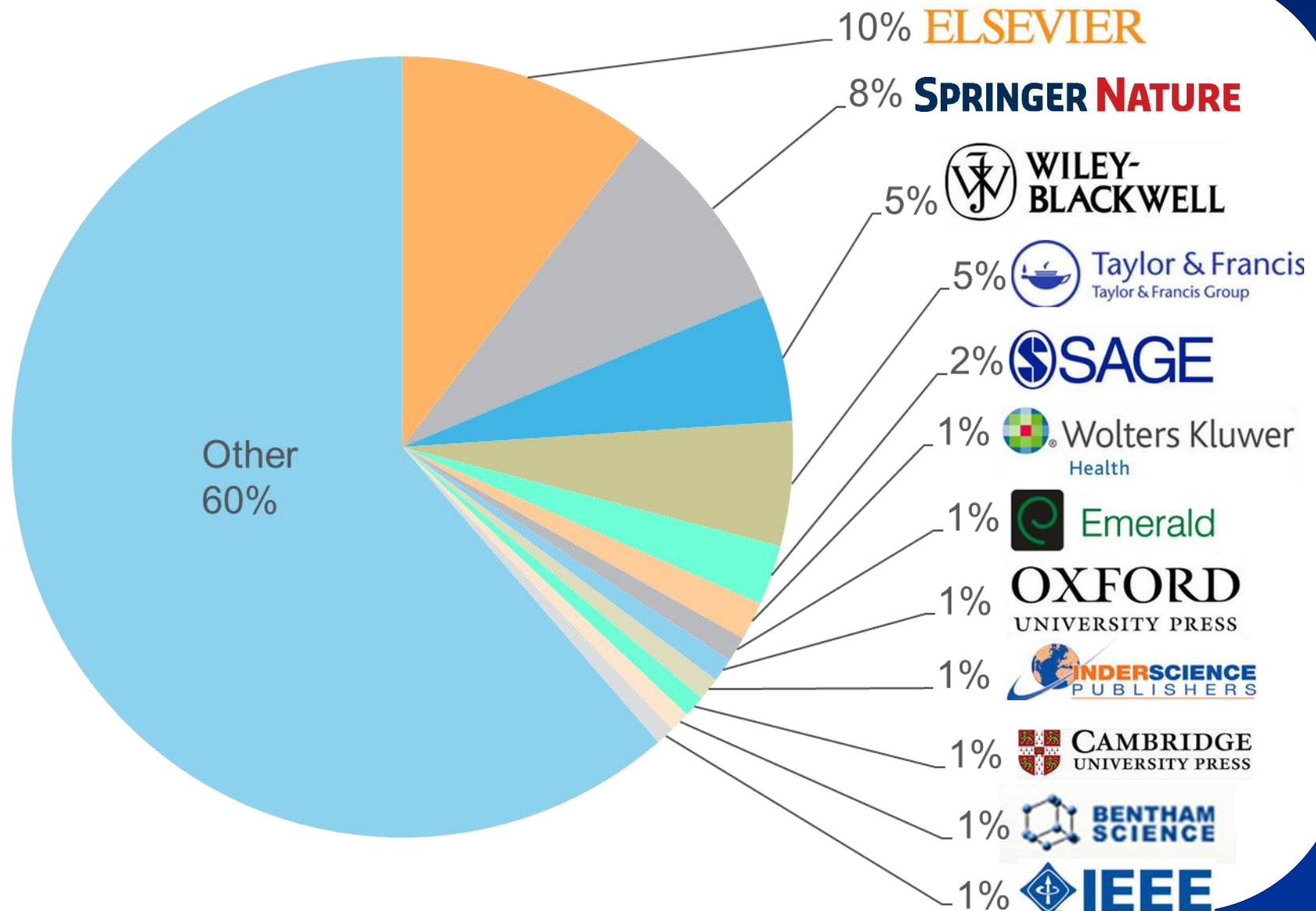

What is Full-Text Database?

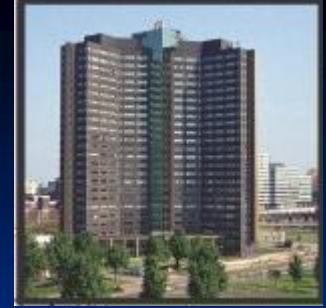
- A database that contains the complete text of books, dissertations, journals, magazines, newspapers or other kinds of textual documents.
- It is opposed both to a bibliographic database (only covering bibliographical information and possibly abstracts and thus being a partial text database) and to a non-bibliographic database (such as, for example, a directory or a numeric database).

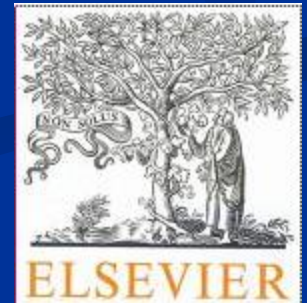

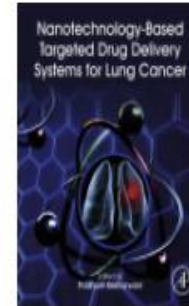

- **Search tip:** None of the available fields are mandatory to an advanced search query.
- You are simply required to complete at least one field with searchable information

Use Boolean operators to combine multiple terms:

- Boolean operators currently supported include AND, OR, NOT, and the hyphen (or minus symbol)
- Boolean operators must be entered in all uppercase
- The hyphen (or minus symbol) is interpreted as the NOT operator

For example: `black -hole` will return results containing 'black', but exclude any instances where 'hole' appears with it.

- Boolean precedence is as follows:
 1. NOT
 2. AND
 3. OR
- Parentheses can be used when nesting clauses so the grouping is clear

For example: For `a OR b AND c`, enter `a OR (b AND c)`

- Quotation marks can be used to specify terms which must appear next to each other

For example: `("heart attack" OR "myocardial infarction") AND diabetes AND NOT cancer`

Advanced Search

- Enter the terms or phrases which must appear in the documents retrieved.
- Quotation marks can be used to specify terms which must appear next to each other in the document. Eg. “heart attack”
- You can use Boolean operators to include or exclude other terms in your search.
Notice they must be in uppercase.
 - (“heart attack” OR “myocardial infarction”) AND diabetes AND NOT cancer

Advanced Search

- You can limit your search to documents by specific authors.
- And ,using a minus sign, you can exclude specific authors or collaborations.eg. mcmanus-chen
- The above example can be expressed more concisely as: (“heart attack” OR “myocardial infarction”) diabetes –cancer

Advanced Search

- You can enter a publishing year or date range for the documents, or leave the field blank if you want documents from all years available.
- Using a hyphen, you can specify a date range. **eg. 2016-2018**
- You can Refine the search to particular types of documents.
